

CLUB REGISTRATION & FEES NEW & EXISTING MEMBERS

Fees for 2018/19

This season will see some changes in the membership fees with a move towards a rolling subscription via bank transfer / Standing Order and an increase on previous seasons.

Annual membership fees:

- £135 for single membership
- £200 for family membership (multi-child)
- £80 for Under 6s (2 payments of £40 in August and £40 in December cash, cheque or your own monthly bank transfer)

Fees have been marginally increased to cover the 20% increase in costs associated with winter training facilities at Ryburn High School/Beech Hill.

How to Pay for those new to the club in 2018-19?

The membership is for an 8 month-long season (September to April), with an initial signing on fee of $\underline{\textbf{£45}}$ (single) or $\underline{\textbf{£66.64}}$ (family) required before the start of every season.

We appreciate the burden of paying all the fees at once, everyone has the option to pay monthly (via a bank transfer or standing-order), however this needs to be set-up and a payments received before the start of the season.

Under 6s will pay an introductory price of £80 and therefore much of the below is not applicable. 2 payments are required for Under 6s; £40 in August and £40 in December (the 2nd payment can be spread across the autumn months via bank transfer if preferred).

For all other age groups, after paying your signing-on fee a rolling £11.25 (£16.66 family) monthly payment (over 12 months) will remove the need for a signing-on fee next season as you'll continue to pay throughout May, June, July and August, which becomes your signing on fee for next season.

In 'layman's terms', after this year's signing-on fee of £45 (or £66.64 for family), thereafter £11.25 per month (or £16.66 for family) until you decide to leave the Club will be a simple way to pay.

New payment structure:

£45 initial signing on fee (£66.64 for family membership)

then

£11.25 monthly payment (£16.66 for family membership)

your yearly fees are paid-up after the April payment, but your monthly payment should continue with no future signing-on fee thereafter.

If / when you decide to leave the club, your payment will be / should be stopped at that point. Any over payments will be transferred back to you.

Pay Monthly

Please see options for paying monthly:

Our prefer option is to set-up your own bank transfer and pay directly to Ryburn United (as the vast majority of people do Internet banking)

- Payment should be made to Ryburn United via sort code: 30-93-76 account number: 00675996
- o Payment to be made on the '1st' of each month
 - The initial payment / signing on fee of £45 (£66.64) will need to be paid prior to the end of August though
- Please prefix the reference field of the internet bank transfer with the surname of your child and the age group e.g. AMER_U12

All bank transfer payments to be made on the '1st' of every month please.

Pay in Full

There is a cash or cheque option to pay in full / upfront:

- Cheques should be made payable to Ryburn United Juniors FC.
- For those wanting to pay cash, the only opportunity to do this is at the Registration day, where a receipt will be issued.

No cash or cheques should be handed to coaches, payment to be made direct to a member of the committee.

For existing Members and dealing with small annual increase

All children who participate in either training or matches must be a member of the Club, have completed a registration / consent form and have paid a subscription in place.

Subscription fees for the first time in 4 years will be increasing from 2018-19 to reflect the overall cost of running our football to the Club. Ryburn United FC is a non-profit making organisation run by volunteers.

There are 4 levels of subscription, and annual costs are as follows:

- 1. Under 6s Introduction to Football Membership £80
- 2. Individual Player (U7s to U16s) Membership £135
- 3. Family / Sibling (U7s to U16s) Membership £200
- 4. Transitional Membership (U17s to U18s) £80

The subscription is 'all inclusive' to cover weekly training sessions, equipment, kit and games.

For those paying their subscription by standing order payments for the 2018-19 season have already started (payments operate between May 18- April 19). To account for the increase in fees, the club will write out to you and request the difference between the old subscription and new subscription as a one off payment. For example – if you are paying for an individual subscription the payment has increased from £120 to £135 per season, therefore the club will request a one off payment of £15.

The club will then request your standing orders payments are updated in April 2019, before the start of the 2019 - 20 season begins.

For Registration, the following forms should be completed.

- 2. Huddersfield League registration is now moving to the Whole Game System like the girls section members

All members (new and existing) need to complete at very least the:

- (1) Club registration / consent form and
- (2) Provide and electronic passport style picture of good quality and proof of date of birth

<u>Identification</u>

All members need to provide some of player identification when registering, see below:

- All members it is important to provide your age group manager with an electronic passport photos with you to the registration day or directly via email
- All members it is important to provide your age group manager with an electronic copy of a passport or birth certificate, as this along with the photo is uploaded to the Whole Game System
